#### General comments or concerns about the subject:

I have taught Business Studies for a number of years and am now teaching Accounting, and I don't think there is enough material for this subject to be introduced independently. I believe the Business Studies syllabus should be revised to include Retail as described here, while removing the Accounting topics, besides others. It would be extremely useful for students to have this revised Business Studies subject available and be able to choose it in Form 3 together with Accounting. In my opinion Retail on its own is very limiting to the students and does not allow much space for further development, whereas a newly revised Business Studies subject that incorporates Retail and possibly even other important topics such as Taxation, gives the students a stronger and more varied package of skills for the future whether or not they pursue a business/finance career.
